CALL FOR SINGLE CHANNEL VIDEO for *LUMEN8*

Staten Island Arts is now accepting submissions of single-channel, non-narrative videos from individual artists, groups or organizations working in experimental video interested in participating in *LUMEN8*, an exhibition celebrating the past seven years of Staten Island Arts's LUMEN Festival.

This exhibit will run from June 15 to September 10, 2017 at ArtSpace @ Staten Island Arts. Co-curated by Monica Valenzuela and Raul Barquet, this exhibit will feature video, sound art, performance art, and ephemera from past festival participants and honor the artistic genres that the festival highlights. *LUMEN8* pays homage to this annual festival, pulling select work from the past seven years that we've loved alongside a loop of single-channel video works submitted to Staten Island Arts through this open call.

DEADLINE: The deadline to apply is midnight (EST) Friday, May 26, 2017.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants are required to submit completed single-channel video files by May 26, 2017.

Applicants are not required to be from Staten Island, though Staten Island artists are strongly encouraged to apply. There is no entry fee to apply. All applications are accepted via email only. Do not submit hard-copy materials. They will be disqualified and not be reviewed.

Applications are reviewed by a curatorial team and notifications will go out via email by **Wednesday, May 31, 2017.**

GUIDELINES & DETAILS:

Single-Channel LOOP

- Seeking single-channel video
- Must have a total duration/running time of 10 minutes or less
- Conventional documentaries, fiction, or narrative features are NOT eligible
- Artist required to submit video with application that will be considered for inclusion send mp4 file. If selected file submitted with this application will be included in exhibit. Artist not required to coordinate install & de-install.
- Video submission will be featured as part of a projected video reel with other artists work.

Disclaimer: Final placement, production, and budget are at the discretion of Staten Island Arts.

WORK SAMPLE REQUIREMENTS:

All applications must include a single-channel video up to 10 minutes in length. (You must submit the video you are proposing for inclusion in the festival.)

- ALL videos must be sent as a URL link from either Vimeo or Youtube.
- The URL submitted MUST be for the individual video and not to your Vimeo or Youtube page containing multiple videos.
- There are areas in the application to include passwords if the links you send are private/password protected. We encourage you to use the same password for all videos submitted.
- For help with Vimeo, visit [the Vimeo Help Center](#) and read the section on uploading.
- For help with YouTube, visit [the YouTube Help Guide](#) and read the section on uploading.
- When uploading videos, the conversion process may take several hours. We strongly suggest that you upload and test your videos well in advance of the application deadline.
